Education Fund Scholarships

Purpose of the scholarship

- To provide funding for Eyre Peninsula students moving away from home to study at a South Australian university for the first time after completion of Year 12. Students attending an interstate university may also be eligible if their course is not available in South Australia.
- To help with the costs of books and other resources needed for establishment away from home.

Please note: scholarships will only be paid when students have relocated and are personally attending on campus (ie not for online study).

Application round

Applications will open on **9 March and close on 9 April 2021**.

Successful applicants will be notified in May 2021.

How can students apply?

Application forms available on the www.epcf.com.au website. Remember to supply the supporting documentation requested when forwarding your application.

How many scholarships will be provided?

Two (2) scholarships of \$2,000 each will be available in 2021.

Selection criteria

1. Students must have completed their last years of schooling to Year 12 in a school on Eyre Peninsula.
2. Applicants **must not** be in receipt of a scholarship or funding from another source to assist with studies (other than CSP, Youth Allowance or government fee assistance). Please note you may apply for a scholarship from the EPCF even if you have also applied elsewhere but if you are successful with another source you must notify EPCF immediately.
